⇒ Survival suits are recommended for rescue workers on oil rigs, passenger ships, fishing boats and helicopter transport. This category comprises work suits, day suits and safety/abandonment suits. Dry suits provide adequate flotation and protection against loss of body heat, thus extending survival time in cold water. All suits are approved according to IMO/SOLAS requirements and EU-directives in Europe, as well as the US and Canadian Coast Guard.

Key safety features include high vis striping, SOLAS whistle, D-ring attachment and patches for personal locator beacon. The 78001 will help keep employees Dry, Warm and Safe, at work.
